Subject: Admission under PM CARES for Children Scheme.

Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, Hon'ble Prime Minister has announced PM CARES for Children Scheme for supporting children who have lost both parents or surviving parent or adoptive parents or legal guardians due to COVID-19 pandemic. The objective of the scheme is to ensure comprehensive care and protection of children in a sustained manner including their empowerment through education.

Admissions in KVs shall be granted to the children under the PM CARES for Children Scheme as per following provisions: -

- (i) Admission in KVs to the beneficiaries of PM Cares for Children Scheme be granted in the age appropriate class as and when recommended by District Magistrate of the concerned district.
- (ii) The admission can be granted to 10 children per KV subject to maximum of 02 children per class.
- (iii) Kendriya Vidyalayas are day schools and hence the details of the guardian of the child recommended under this scheme are essential and the same is to be collected before granting admission.
- (iv) Children admitted under this special provision, would be exempted from payment of all fees (Tuition fee, Computer Fund and VVN) from classes I to XII.

As the above provisions have already been notified in KVS Admission Guidelines 2022-23, the necessary directions given in the Guidelines be followed in letter and spirit while giving admissions to the beneficiaries. District Magistrate of the District shall anchor the scheme in the District concerned and send the list of eligible beneficiaries to the Principal of the KV for admission in KV as per the provision & guidelines.

It is requested to instruct the Principals under your Region to coordinate with the respective District Magistrates so that such children can be granted admission in age appropriate class as per provision contained in Para No. 2 above. A copy of the guidelines on PM CARES for Children Scheme & letters received from Ministry of Education are enclosed.

1. A list of 4058 registered eligible beneficiaries under PM Cares Children Scheme received from Ministry of Education is enclosed with this letter. The same may be shared with Principals with a direction to contact the school details of the beneficiaries with supporting documents as per direction of Ministry of Education and also facilitate admissions to those children who are not in school system. District in which KVs are not established so far, the principal of the KVs of the neighbouring districts may be asked to coordinate. **An official of the region may be designated as Nodal Officer for coordination with stakeholders for admission of the children under the scheme.**
2. In case, the Principal is unable to contact the guardian of registered eligible beneficiaries under PM Cares Children Scheme through the given phone number, then the Principal may be instructed to coordinate with Child Welfare Committee of the District available on <https://pmcaresforchildren.in/> (List enclosed for ready reference).
3. After contacting Child Welfare Committee of the District, if the Principal is unable to contact the guardian of registered eligible beneficiaries under PM Cares Children Scheme the same may be intimated to this office immediately through a consolidated sheet from your office for apprising the same to the Ministry.
4. An excel sheet is being shared with a request to update the school details of the eligible registered beneficiaries with supporting documents, if available, and the same may be verified from your end by **03.03.2022 positively** and send the updated list including school details of registered eligible beneficiaries under PM Cares Children Scheme through the email Id dcacad02kvshq@gmail.com for onward submission to Ministry.
